

Teaching and Learning Committee Terms of Reference 2025-26

The purpose of the Teaching and Learning Committee (TLC) is to support and challenge the senior leadership in continually improving the standards of teaching and learning at the school. Specifically:

1. To monitor and evaluate the implementation of the School Improvement Plan (SIP)
2. To monitor and evaluate the provision of professional development of staff, in relation to the SIP.
3. To evaluate the school performance through analysis of school-based and any other available statistical data.
4. To have an understanding and overview of all curriculum areas, especially literacy and numeracy, and their place within the broader school curriculum.
5. To ensure the school is meeting the requirements of the National Curriculum, and oversee the governing body's statutory curriculum responsibilities, including
 - a. Relationships & Sex Education (RSE)
 - b. Religious education
 - c. Collective worship
6. To review, with staff, curriculum policies as required, and make recommendations to the governing body.
7. To explore opportunities for enriching the curriculum.
8. To monitor provision for, personalised learning and progress of and policies relating to all children who:
 - a. have special educational needs and/or disabilities
 - b. are looked after
 - c. are gifted and/or talented
 - d. are newly arrived in this country
9. To monitor the provision and progress for emergent, fluent and EAL children.
10. To monitor the use and effectiveness of the Pupil Premium and the Sports Premium.
11. To monitor the policies and systems relating to standards of pupils' behaviour.

The membership will not be fewer than four governors plus a member of the senior leadership team

Quorum will be three governors.

There will be two meetings each term.
